landfill: a landfill is a place where garbage is taken and is covered with dirt.


garbage: garbage is anything that you throw away.





decompose: when something decomposes, it means it breaks down into smaller and smaller pieces until its gone.



environment: environment means all the things in nature: plants, animals, the water we drink, and the air we breathe.



reuse: when you reuse something, it means you use it again.






cans can be reused in all sorts of ways.
